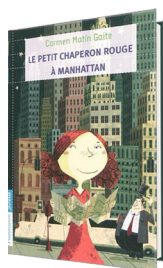


Recommendations for funny French books

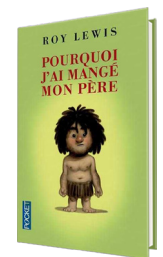
MON NEZ, MON CHAT, L'AMOUR ET... MOI

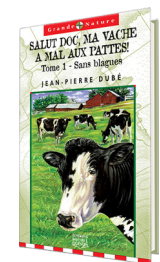


LA DOUBLE VIE DE ROSALIE : OPÉRATION BARBIE NINJA
