

Le chemin du cœur

There are many French expressions containing the word cœur (heart). Learn a few of them and discover what they mean with this fun board game.

Rules

Before playing

- Print out the game board and cards.
- Cut out each card.
- Use uncooked macaroni as game pieces. Paint them a different colour for each player.
- You'll need one die to play the game.

How to play

- 1) Place the cards face down near the board.
- 2) Place all the macaroni game pieces on the “start” square.
- 3) Take turns rolling the die. The youngest person goes first.
- 4) The number each person rolls indicates how many squares they can move their piece forward.

Be careful!

- If a player lands on a square marked with a cross, the player to their right draws a card.
- That player reads the expression and the three possible meanings on the card out loud.
- The player who landed on the square tries to guess which one is correct.
- If they're right, they can leave their piece in the same spot.
- If they're wrong, they have to move their piece back one square.
- The next player rolls the die, and the game continues until someone reaches the heart.

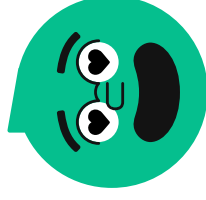
