Knowing how to recognize sounds is one of the first steps in learning how to read.

Here's a fun game to get your child off to a good start.

Instructions:

- 1. Print out the pages and choose one.
- 2. Set a realistic goal (e.g., get three or more correct answers).
- 3. Ask questions based on our suggestions.
- 4. Give your child a reward when they achieve the goal (e.g., a sticker, three kisses).
- 5. Start again!


Suggested questions for practising sounds:
