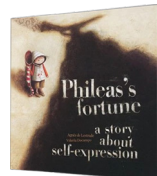
Sam and Watson are inseparable. The day Sam leaves for school, his friend Watson decides to follow him and find out what goes on in class. He soon understands why school is so important.

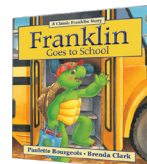
