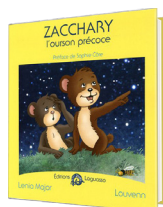

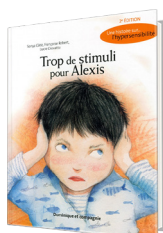


MAX TROUVE QUE C'EST PAS JUSTE (FRENCH ONLY)

For gifted children, empathy is often linked with anxiety. This story explores how the most well-intentioned people can struggle to help someone with high potential.

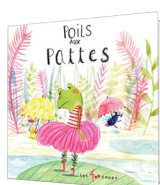


GLOBAL CONFLICT

Gifted children tend to be curious. Eager for knowledge, they often like reading and watching the news. If your child is curious about world events, this book can answer all their questions.

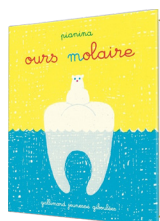


POILS AUX PATTES (FRENCH ONLY)

It's quite common for children with high potential to feel alone in the world. Gertrude the furry-legged frog also knows what it's like to be different!

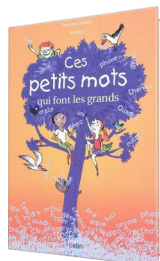


OURS MOLAIRE (FRENCH ONLY)
