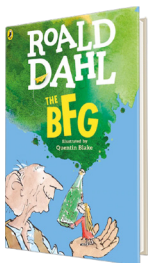
Four unusual children are recruited by Mr. Benedict, a strange man who subjects them to a series of unusual tests to prepare them for a dangerous mission.

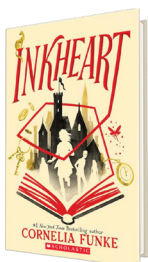
The BFG is a classic children's tale about Sophie and her unlikely new friend—a big, friendly giant!
