Research shows that students who use Alloprof gain confidence, autonomy, and motivation, three factors that play a major role in students' academic perseverance and success.







Our services

Ask a question



From Monday to Thursday, 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. and Sundays from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.



Students ask our teachers questions by phone or text message.



The most immediate experience between the student and our teachers. The student can ask questions live in the website's chat room as soon as a difficulty arises.

Reviewing for an exam

Live Reviews are videos approximately one hour in length wherein a teacher reviews a specific subject area in preparation for exams.




Crash Lessons are short tutorials on priority learning, including a 15-minute video with questions to check for understanding.




The goal is to give English-speaking students in Quebec the same high-quality experience we offer their francophone peers.


Artificial intelligence to improve students' experiences

Automated personal readers to increase accessibility

In collaboration with the Institut de valorisation des données (IVADO) and software engineering graduates from ÉTS in Montreal, Alloprof has created a tool that generates on-demand audio playback of some texts on its website.

By making it possible to listen to Alloprof's content, this customized solution **enhances learning accessibility** for younger students, students with reading disabilities, and those with limited literacy skills. An English version is coming soon!





An automated system that suggests Help Zone explanations

We worked with Polytechnique Montréal and IVADO to develop an algorithm that has been integrated into the Help Zone (HZ) to provide students with recommendations based on their questions. Now, a student will get immediate explanations related to their question. Alloprof's teachers are notified so that they can provide a personalized explanation as soon as possible.



Here are a few of our major successes that help students even more:


- Major redesign of geography in French and English as a Second Language.

Meeting Indigenous students

Alloprof travelled beyond La Tuque to the shores of Rivière Saint-Maurice and the banks of Lake Pekuakami (near Roberval in Lac-Saint-Jean), to meet with the Atikamekw community of Wemotaci and the Innu community of Mashteuiatsh. While there, we connected with local players and students to propel the Alloprof Reflex while providing useful resources to use throughout their school career. We see, moving forward, several other mutual collaborations!

Our tutors
















We strive to help more young people more often
