

Coveo, a Quebec company, is helping Alloprof set up and optimize a state-of-the-art search engine. In particular, these developments have improved the correction of misspelled terms, as well as the filtering and display of search results. Now, students can more swiftly and easily find answers for their questions on Alloprof's different platforms!

In order to expedite access to high-quality pedagogical explanations, Alloprof has integrated a recommendation engine that identifies the student's needs by analyzing their question, and then suggests up to three pieces of content from the Alloprof website that best addresses their question.






Alloprof's first mascot

Alloprof continues its on-site efforts and renews its virtual and in-person presentation offerings. For instance, the new workshops include quizzes and tips on organization and study habit





More intensive support during summer classes

Alloprof visits to schools during summer classes have encouraged students who are struggling to use its services. This year, **twice as many students** were reached.

During the summer, the organization was able to provide mothan 574 000 educational interactions on its platform, and its teachers were able to directly answer 1000 academic questions.

Meeting Indigenous students

To introduce Atikamekw and Ilnu students to Alloprof's best resources, our team travelled through the spruce forests of Haute-Mauricie, then along the shores of the Pekuakami (Lac Saint-Jean) to meet them in person. Through storytelling, interactive quizzes, and online games, the students were introduced to Alloprof's many tools.

A new story

By partnering with Puakuteu, an Indigenous non-profit in Mashteuiatsh, we were able to add the first Ilnu story to our reading game, Book of Spells, in Nehlueun—the language of the territory. In French, the story is called "Shimun, le lutin des bois"!






