Time flies when you're having fun! So, what better way to help your students learn to tell time than with the help of a fun character? They'll soon see how easy learning with Flo can be.


Instructions:


Cut out the clock and the clock hands.

Attach the hands to the clock with a paper fastener.


Avenues to explore:

- 1) Explain the following to your class:
 - An hour is made up of 60 minutes.
 - A minute is made up of 60 seconds.
 - A clock face shows 12 hours.
 - The longest hand is the second hand-it counts the seconds and never stops.
 - The medium hand is the minute hand–it moves forward every 60 seconds.
 - The smallest hand is the hour hand-it moves forward every 5 minutes.
 - Etc.
- 2) Ask your students to do the following:
 - Find the smallest hand and read the number it's pointing to.
 - Find the medium hand and read the number it's pointing to.
 - Say what time is indicated on the clock.
 - Etc.
- 3) Provide your students with the exercise sheet below.
