Important!

All questions <u>must</u> be answered with the help of the documents in the Document File. When the question indicates which documents should be used, these must be used otherwise no points will be awarded.

Tips for Using the Document File

- Take the time to read and analyze the Document File before the questions.
- Use highlighters to analyze each document.
- Use a document analysis method like the 5W to identify important information in each document.


