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**This version of exquisite corpse is a great way to develop a child's interest in English.
We've provided some sample sentence structures below to get you started!**

How to play

1. Print out this sheet.
2. Each child takes a turn writing a part of a sentence on each strip.
3. A child folds the paper back once their sentence strip is written so as to hide it from the next player.
4. Each sentence strip shows the parts of speech that must be included, but players can add their own creative ideas too!
5. Once the paper has been completed, unfold it and read aloud.
The result should be a funny, nonsensical story for all to enjoy!
