How to Build a Great Cheat Sheet





Write your name, the date, and the name of the subject at the top of the page.

Identify each section

Group similar information into sections and use titles or labels.

Write small (but not too small!) and be concise.

Use a well sharpened pencil. This will help you write smaller.

What to include

Use symbols, diagrams, and abbreviate as much as possible.



Make certain content stand out

You can highlight important information

You can circle key words

Use a colour code. Different colours on your cheat sheet will help you spot information quickly. Use a variety of colours to underline key words, circle important formulas, highlight important facts, etc.

Don't hesitate to put examples, formulas, important dates and even step-by-step procedures.
