1	The dimension lines are outside the object.				
2	The extension lines are perpendicular to their corresponding dimension lines.				
	There is a gap of about 2 mm between the extension lines and the objects.				
	The extension lines extend 2 mm beyond the dimension lines.				
3	There is a gap of at least 10 mm between the side of an object and the dimension lines or between two dimension lines.				
4	A centre line is used as an extension line.				
5	A single extension line is used for more than one dimension.				
6	The shorter dimension lines are in front of the longer ones.				
7	The dimension lines are outside the extension lines for dimensions that are too small.				
8	The leader line is drawn at an angle of 45° and points toward the centre of the circle.				
9	The radius is identified with the symbol R, and the diameter is identified with the symbol DIA or Ø.				
10	The dimension line of an angle is curved.
