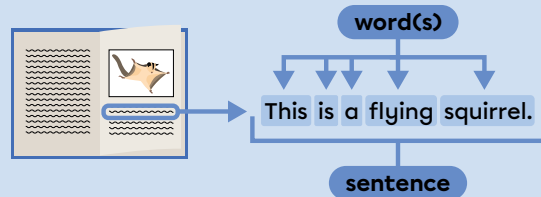

Basic Grammar Terms



parts of speech

Categories of words

noun

Names a person, a place, a thing or an idea.

adjective

Describes a noun.

verb

Expresses an action or a state of being.

pronoun

Replaces a noun.

adverb

Describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb.

determiner

Clarifies if a noun is specific, general, possessed or quantified.

preposition

Links words together indicating time, place or direction.

conjunction

Connects parts of a sentence together.

interjection

Expresses reactions or feelings.

verb tense

Indicates when an action happens: past, present or future.

irregular verb

Verb that has a special form for the past tense.

to go → went
to think → thought

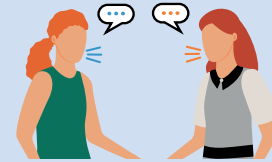
